Oshkosh Area Job Fair October 12 Features More Than 80 Companies; Job Seekers at All Skill Levels Encouraged to Attend

The annual Oshkosh Area Job Fair will be held 1-4 pm on Tuesday, October 12, at Oshkosh Arena (formerly the Menominee Nation Arena), 1212 S. Main Street, Oshkosh. More than 80 employers from across the region will feature a wide mix of available positions including office, service, manufacturing, healthcare, and other professional positions. In just three hours, job seekers can meet with over 80 of the region's employer representatives.

"We welcome any and all job seekers to attend the fair" says Anthony Snyder, CEO of Fox Valley Workforce Development Board. There will be a variety of roles: entry level or more skilled, seasonal, temporary, full and part-time. All job seekers regardless of age, education and work experience are welcome. Some employers will offer on-site interviews while others will be accepting resumes and will schedule interviews at a later date.

"Too often, job seekers can feel like they're sending resumes into an abyss," said Snyder, "You might apply and hear nothing. Where else can you meet with more than 80 employers face-to-face in just one day?"
